



ARE YOU AN INDIVIDUAL, FAMILY OR GROUP PLANNING TO VOLUNTEER IN A BUSY SMALL NGO IN ZAMBIA? THEN MMC IS THE ANSWER.

Maboshe Memorial Centre - MMC is a child disability not-for-profit making community development organisation with no religious or political affiliations founded on the 24th November, 2006 in memories of the late Dr. Rodney Aongola Maboshe in Mongu, Western, Zambia and registered under the laws of Zambia, focusing on helping adolescent with disabilities with Humanitarian aid, Women governance & Human Rights, Climate change & disaster risk reduction, clean safe Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH), Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM), Community shelter, Women & youth economic empowerment, Child legal aid (Child Protection), Sexual reproductive health rights, HIV prevention, Inclusive technical and vocational skills training, Inclusive education sponsorship (primary, secondary & tertiary), Drug abuse, Disaster Risk Reduction and Management, Child disabilities learning centre and Young school gardening farmers clubs.

When you volunteer in MMC you are giving something back to the community by lending a helping hand to children and organization. What you may not realize is that volunteering in MMC also benefits you as an individual. There are many good reasons to get involved in our community development programs, including learning something about you. MMC offers volunteer an opportunities for both teens and adults.

Volunteers are always needed in a wide range of worthy projects in areas of community access to clean safe Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH), Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM), community shelter, economic empowerment, legal aid, sexual reproductive health rights, HIV prevention, vocational and education sponsorships, ICTs, clothing, entrepreneurship, healthcares, etc.

No need of previous experience, as with all our volunteer programs, we provide the tools and training needed to support your placement. When a volunteer arrives in Mongu district, Western province, Zambia, our Volunteer Coordinator meets them at the airport and brings them to our orientation place in Mongu district, Western province, Zambia. From that point our volunteers spend between 2 to 3 days in our orientation program. This training provides volunteers with a very detailed understanding of how to acquaint in Mongu district, Western province, Zambia's life and culture.

WHAT WILL BE YOUR COMMITMENT WITH THE MABOSHE MEMORIAL CENTRE – MMC?

1. Volunteer Abroad travel to Mongu, Western Province, Zambia, (Fundraising strategies to enable volunteers' trip from their country to & from the project sites, the program package include: flights, insurance, visas, vaccinations, departure from the program).
2. Education (Namakau Mukelabai Child Disabilities Learning Centre).
3. Education sponsorship.
4. Child Aid Projects – a MMC community development project in lines of activities designed to assist families in each project in an organized way to improve their living condition for the sake of the children, activities include health and hygiene, education, strengthening the economy of the families through income generating activities, life skills training, environmental activities, sports and culture, and operation of preschools.
5. Shelter (Namakau Mukelabai Child Disabilities Centre).
6. Fundraisings events for disabled, orphans and vulnerable girls programs.
7. Fundraise for your cause (Donate your special occasion to change lives).
8. Run for disabled, orphans and vulnerable girls projects (Raise funds for a good cause).
9. Advocate for children's rights (Urge lawmakers to take action for children's needs).
10. Find an event or concert and volunteer (Share child sponsorship with even attendees).
11. Find sponsors for disabled, orphans and vulnerable girls (Child Ambassadors).
12. Host a sponsorship event (Host an event to share child sponsorship).
13. Volunteer your labor (Help at Maboshe Memorial Centre - MMC centres and Offices).
14. Professional Advisors (Share giving resources with clients).
15. Volunteer events (Sponsor or raise funds for one of our volunteers events by providing in-kind donations).
16. In-kind support (Donations/contributions including secondhand clothes, shoes, toys, computers, photocopiers etc for disabled, orphans and vulnerable girls and the centres).
17. Sponsor a Child in Western Province, Zambia: - (Find people who can pay school, college and university fees for the disabled, orphans

and vulnerable girls, there are a huge number of children who are either partially or totally orphaned or vulnerable due to HIV-AIDS; they don't get basic necessities like food clothing access to education and even shelter. They suffer the cruelty of both freezing cold and hot sun. Due to poor living conditions that their widowed parents and unable guardians subject them to, these children die of malnutrition and lack of access to medical or emotional care. The nature of your hearts can bring a significant change to our environment; more especially to the people we see around but don't necessarily live with.

WHAT WILL BE THE MABOSHE MEMORIAL CENTRE – MMC COMMITMENTS WITH YOU (VOLUNTEERS)?

1. **Accommodation:** (MMC will accommodate you at the project site or stay with host families or at the MMC community housing centre. There are provisions for beds, mattresses bed sheets and mosquito nets. The bathroom facilities range from pit latrines, bathing may consist of a basin of water, with solar electricity).
2. **Meals:** (MMC will provide meals (breakfast, refreshments, lunch, and dinner); Western province villages rely on a simple, largely vegetarian diet. A national dish called Mbuahobwe means- Nshima, rice, potatoes, sweet potatoes, and green vegetables are also important to the African diet. Sometimes, meat from goats, chicken, or cows is included. You may find fish near the Zambezi River. Fresh fruit (e.g., banana, watermelon, pineapple, mango -- depending on the season) are abundant as well).
3. Airport pickup: On arrival date.
4. Training: In-country orientation.
5. The opportunity to stay connected with your project.
6. Facilitation transportation within Zambia.
7. Health Insurance.
8. Allowance for basic needs.
9. Security, safety and guidance.
10. **Tour and Safaris:** - (Volunteering is quite intensive and volunteers are advised to take short breaks during their volunteer time to do sightseeing e.g. visit Traditional home set up, Boat-Riding etc. Western Province is the most beautiful province with lots of adventures and Barotse Plains landscape one would want to explore before returning home. For low cost tours we recommend adventure companies that can always be helpful in organizing safari packages in Western province at affordable rates).
11. Think about how much you receive when you give and consider why you want to volunteer in the Mabushe Memorial Centre - MMC.
 - Learn to be responsible for themselves and others
 - Make new friends
 - Increase your self confidence
 - Discover your talents and hidden skills
 - Develop marketable job skills
 - Learn from, serve and be served by a different culture

 - Certificate of completion depending on the volunteer hours not less than 50 hours

12. **Required skills:** - (Volunteers do not need to have any skills or knowledge about that project activity, as they will mainly be doing unskilled work such as digging, mixing sand and cement, carrying rocks, sand and bricks, fetching water, painting, teaching, office work, etc. They will be led by MMC skilled locals and work together with local community. Get your hands dirty to make a difference).

14. Languages required: English

Who can volunteer? Anyone, for 19 of age with families or groups support, 20 years and above of age is welcome to become a MMC Executive

Representative or MMC Community Development Instructor since the application form for children is filled by the adult family members and return to the MMC Executive Representative.

Commitment: We have 1 to 3 months maximum. If you want to stay longer, we'll work it out if the space is available.

Program costs: The cost to volunteer with MMC for a month is US\$ 250 and for 3 months is US\$ 750 (Payment before your arrival in Zambia).

Notes: It is mandatory for you to get appropriate vaccines with the advice from your doctor and also it is advisable to come along with your travel and medical insurance for the placement duration.
